Naturalization of New Citizens to Commemorate Celebration of Constitution Day at the Old Courthouse

WHERE: Jefferson National Expansion Memorial, Historic Old Courthouse,
11 North Fourth Street in St. Louis, Missouri.

WHEN: **Friday, September 17, 2010**

WHAT: The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service, in cooperation with the National Park Service at Jefferson National Expansion Memorial will commemorate Constitution Day with a public naturalization ceremony at the Old Courthouse on **Friday, September 17, 2010**.

Approximately 75 prospective United States citizens will take the oath of citizenship at the ceremony, which will begin at **1:00 p.m.** in the rotunda of the Old Courthouse.

The public is invited to attend this special naturalization ceremony. All events and exhibits at the Old Courthouse are free of charge.

The Old Courthouse is FREE and open to the public daily 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and is closed Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years Day.
