Children ages 5 and up can earn a special Junior Ranger patch and certificate by completing activities at the Museum of Westward Expansion (located beneath the Gateway Arch). Activities will include a special outdoor Quest! Program, indoor building activities and coloring sheets. There will also be a special exhibit of ranger uniform items and badges from different eras of National Park Service history, and short segments from Ken Burn's documentary, *The National Parks: America's Best Idea*.

Junior Ranger Day is a national effort to encourage families to get out and discover something new about your 394 national parks. This year's focus, *Healthy Parks, Healthy People*, highlights the connection between human and environmental health and the vital role America's national parks play in both.

The Gateway Arch is open daily 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.  
Summer hours: Memorial Day - Labor Day daily 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.  
The Old Courthouse is open daily year round 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The Gateway Arch and Old Courthouse are closed Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years Day.
