WHEN: Saturday, June 18, 2011 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

WHAT: Dr. Tim Stout will help you improve your "eye" for perceiving good nature subjects and your skill for creating beautiful pictures that will attract others to the natural world. This program will increase your interest and enjoyment of nature photography by providing a working knowledge of technique and equipment.

Primarily a nature photographer, Dr. Stout received The Photographic Society of America's (PSA) Gold Medal in the "Best of the Best 2008-2009 Inter-Club International Competition" category, and his photographs were published in the July issue of PSA, including one on the cover. He has received many honors and awards from the St. Louis Camera Club, and is head of the nature section. As a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine, he has always been focused on the natural world.

Workshop is FREE of charge and open to the public, but limited to 30 participants, so registration is required by phoning 877-982-1410.

This workshop is one of a series of seven offered in conjunction with the "View from the Park" Photo Contest, where shutterbugs of all ages are invited to submit up to two photos in each of three categories: nature, landscape and architecture. All photographs must be taken by the entrant and within the boundary of Jefferson National Expansion Memorial. The contest runs May 15, 2011 through July 31, 2011.
