"The Beauty of Photography" Photography Workshop

WHERE: Jefferson National Expansion Memorial, The Old Courthouse, Special Exhibit Gallery,

WHEN: Sunday, June 12, 2011 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

WHAT: Jim Trotter, a local photographer and the owner of Trotter Art, will present a workshop emphasizing wide-angle photography, which will include a demonstration of a GigaPan system. The GigaPan allows users to capture multiple "gigapixel" sized images and stitch them together to create beautiful, wide-angle panoramic pictures.

Jim Trotter is a commercial photographer who produces commercial images for clients, makes portraits, and has published books on St. Louis, including his most recent work: *The Best of St. Louis*.

Workshop is FREE of charge and open to the public, but limited to 30 participants, so registration is required by phoning 877-982-1410.

This workshop is one of a series of seven offered in conjunction with the "View from the Park" Photo Contest, where shutterbugs of all ages are invited to submit up to two photos in each of three categories: nature, landscape and architecture. All photographs must be taken by the entrant and within the boundary of Jefferson National Expansion Memorial. The contest runs May 15, 2011 through July 31, 2011.
